Recital Day Procedures

Before the Show – Arrival Instructions

- Arrive one hour before your child's scheduled show time.
- Your child should arrive fully dressed in costume, with hair and makeup complete.
- Please ensure your child is not wearing any jewelry.
- For our youngest dancers – do not pack bags, snacks, lipstick, makeup, toys or personal belongings.
- For older dancers in more than one routine – please label any bags, costumes or shoes with your child's name.
- Follow the posted signs to the designated backstage area.

Check-In Procedure

- Please provide your child's first and last name.
- Please let us know any known allergies or special needs.
- You will be issued a colored bracelet that corresponds with your child's name and class.
- You will also be assigned a routine pick-up number, which correlates with a designated waiting area for post-show dismissal.
- This bracelet must be worn and presented at pick-up to ensure safe student release.

Backstage Access Rules

- Only approved backstage crew and designated parent volunteers will be permitted backstage.
- If your child has a costume change, you will be granted permission to assist backstage. Please make sure to wear your bracelet.
- For the safety and efficiency of all performers, our staff will strictly enforce backstage access rules.

Food Policy

- No food or snacks are permitted backstage due to allergy concerns.
- Water and allergy-friendly snacks will be available as needed.
- Please ensure your child eats before arriving.

During the Show

- All students will remain in the backstage area for the entire duration of the recital.
- Do not attempt to retrieve your child during the performance, as this disrupts the show and causes confusion.
- Backstage volunteers will be present to supervise, assist, and support all students.
- Should there be any issues backstage, we will be able to find you and connect you with your child.

After the Show – Pick-Up Procedure

- Following the Finale, students will be returned to the backstage drop off area and released one class at a time in ascending age order:
--Baby Dance, Pre School 1, Pre School 2, Kinder Combo, Hip Hop Ages 5–8, Primary Combo, Hip Hop Ages 9–12, Intermediate Combo, Teen Classes
--Note: There may be more than one class within the same age group)
- Proceed to the designated pick-up area that matches your routine pick-up number.
- Only one parent or guardian wearing the correct color-coded bracelet will be permitted into the pick-up area.

Verification and Dismissal

- Children will remain with their class and designated backstage parent at their group's area until called.
- Students will be released one group at a time, to ensure safety and accountability.
- Bracelets will be checked for identity verification before any child is released.
- After picking up your child we ask that you promptly exit the area to help reduce congestion and allow space for the next group. You will exit out the side door – it will be clearly marked.
- Please ask all other family members to leave out the main auditorium doors (where you entered). You can walk to the parking lot to meet them from the side door.

Final Reminders

- Ensure your child is fed a meal before arrival. We will have allergen friendly snacks and water backstage. DO NOT pack food.
- Please be patient and respectful to our staff and volunteers—your cooperation ensures an organized, safe and enjoyable experience for all.

Getting Ready for Recital

MAKEUP FOR AGES 5+

- **EYESHADOW:**
Apply brown eye shadow across the lid and white eye shadow in the crease and under the brow-line.
- **MASCARA:**
Apply a generous amount of mascara to both the upper and lower lashes.
- **BLUSH:**
Apply a natural pink to the apples of the cheek only (please no bronzer, fuchsia, or red blushes)
- **LIPSTICK:**
Apply lipstick to the upper and lower lips (if the lipstick bleeds; try using a lip-liner first) the color we suggest using for Picture Day and Recital is a wine or blush tone.

*OLDER STUDENTS MAY NEED TO USE CONCEALER IF NEEDED, TO EVEN OUT THE SKIN

*TOUCH-UPS WILL BE MADE BY THE BACKSTAGE HELP WHERE NEEDED

MAKEUP FOR AGES 2-4

- Because the lighting on the stage can wash tiny little faces out, we recommend a light application of blush, light colored lipstick in a rosy pink / lip gloss and a little mascara.

HAIRSTYLES

- Class hairstyles are listed in your costume instructions. Most classes will have a low bun as their designated hairstyle for Recital.



Ticket Day Procedures

- Ticket sales will begin Saturday May 30th at 10:00am. Ticket sales will close that evening and restart again Monday June 1st at 10:00am. Tickets may be purchased in unlimited quantities at that time.

- There is a SEVEN TICKET LIMIT per family, per show on Ticket Day. *This rule applies to Ticket Day only.* This rule ensures that all families will be able to purchase tickets to the Recital. To make sure that no one purchases more than 7 tickets – ticket sales will be closely monitored by the studio staff. Should you purchase more than 7 tickets by using another person's email, you can expect a phone call from the studio instructing you how to return any extra tickets you purchased. If a last name not in our system purchases tickets on Ticket Day, the transaction will be immediately canceled and refunded. This is to prevent families from having other family members or friends purchase extra tickets for them.
- 7 tickets are issued to the account (family) name on file, not per child or per guardian. Families who have shared guardianship of a child do not get 7 tickets each guardian, the limit is per account (family). The 7 tickets may be divided however you see fit.
- If you need to purchase tickets to multiple shows they should be selected in the same transaction/session. Please note you will need to purchase different sets of tickets– a different set for each show. You will have a limit of 7 tickets per family, per show. When purchasing, please make sure to choose the correct Recital Show. If you purchase tickets to the wrong show you can exchange them for tickets to the correct show but you will not be guaranteed the same seats.
- To purchase your tickets, head to our special TutuTix page on your computer, tablet, or smartphone at <https://buy.tututix.com/encoredanceacademy> or you can call 855–222–2TIX (2849) option 1.
- If your party requires handicap seats you will need to call into Tututix.
- Ticket prices are: \$27.00 per ticket. Please note that you will need a credit or debit card to buy tickets, and that tickets will be sold on a first–come, first–serve basis. TutuTix charges a low, fair fee for their service. You'll see their ticket fee, plus processing charge added to your order at checkout.
- Children ages 4 and under do not require a ticket. However, they **MUST** be able to sit on someone's lap quietly without disrupting the view of other attendees. Please note that **ALL STUDENTS** will remain backstage for the entire show and will not be allowed to sit with you in the auditorium. Therefore they will **NOT** need a ticket.
- You'll have several options for how you want your tickets delivered. You can have it emailed to you, sent to your mobile phone internet browser, and even add it to your Apple Passbook (if you have the latest iPhone software) at no charge! Or, you can choose to have TutuTix mail you foil–embossed keepsake tickets for an additional fee—with your dancer's name printed directly on the ticket!
- Tickets will not be sold at the studio at any time. Online ticket sales are open until two hours prior to each show.

Picture Week

June 1st – June 6th

Location:

- Photos will be taken at our 1349 Main Street location.

Schedule:

- Picture Week schedules are listed in your Recital Handbook.
- Photo times may differ from regular class times. Please review your assigned schedule carefully.
- Group photos will begin promptly at the start of each scheduled session.
- Individual photos will follow group photos.
- Dance Company photo schedules will be emailed separately.

Before You Arrive:

- Arrive in costume and ready for photos.
- Hair, makeup, and costume requirements are outlined in the Recital Handbook.
- Parents should escort their child to Picture Day and assist with any necessary costume changes.

Additional Information:

- Ordering information will be available at the studio.
- The studio will be closed for regular classes during Picture Week.
- Sibling photos are available. Please bring both children to the Picture Day session of your choosing.

Reminders:

- Check your assigned photo time carefully.
- Arrive photo-ready; hair and makeup done.
- Group photos begin promptly at the scheduled start time.

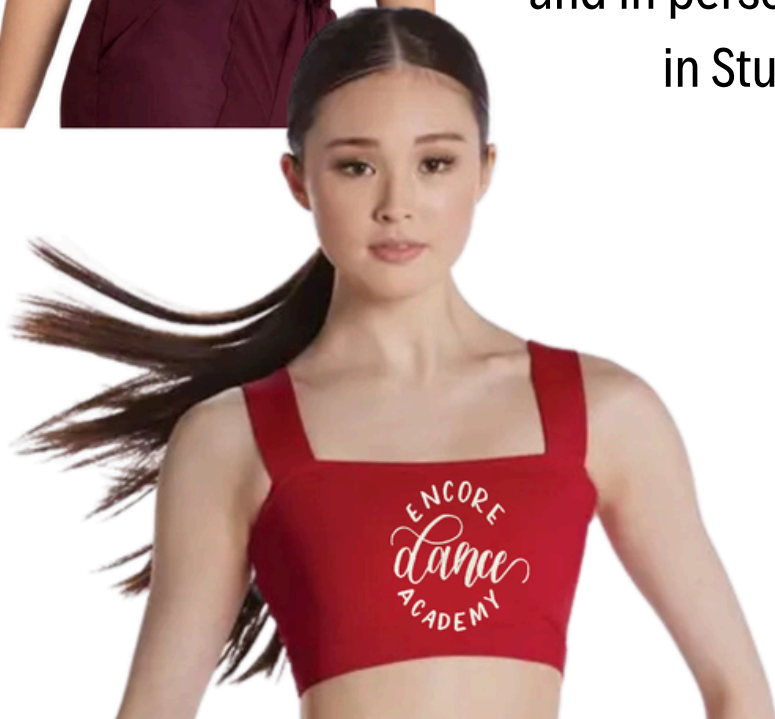
